Ingenio Legal Tech

How Prototype helped move from ambiguous goals to shipped software.



Situation

A legal-tech MVP needed permissions, onboarding, and workflow clarity in a regulated domain — not bolted on after the fact.

Constraints

Relationship-based access control, sensitive professional workflows, domain-specific product structure, and limited capital.

What we did

Implemented relationship-based ACL/RBAC, onboarding flows, authorization models, and legal-tech workflow design aligned to how firms actually operate.

Deliverables

Legal-tech MVP with permissions architecture, onboarding, authorization layers, and domain-specific product structure.

Highlights

- Relationship-based ACL/RBAC — not generic role tables
- Onboarding flows tuned to regulated professional context
- Workflow design before feature sprawl
- Investor-ready product foundation

Outcome: Investor-ready product foundation with governance-aware workflows suitable for a regulated professional domain.
